

UPDATE from NCA
Message from the President.....

Happy spring and summer to all of you. The NCA is in the process of preparing for the “new normal”, whatever that may be; and, we would like to get some input from our Nevada chiropractors.

First, let me share good news from the Chiropractic Physicians Board of Nevada (CPBN). The Board met on April 14, 2022 and voted to approve a one-time reduction in D.C. license renewal fee of \$100 for 2022 and a one-time reduction in CA certification renewal fee of \$50 for 2023. The NCA was instrumental in bringing this proposal before the Board for consideration and promoted this as a way to help chiropractors recover from the pandemic and the cost and decreased revenue during the Covid-19 crisis. Also, the Board approved up to 4 CEUs biennially for any licensed DC or certified CA who attends a scheduled Board meeting.
